SAN BERNARDINO, CA— San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) is excited to announce the start of phase I of the restoration of Civil services into the West End and High Desert regions of our county.

Beginning Monday, December 11, 2023, select civil matters, which fall under the jurisdiction of the Rancho Cucamonga and Victorville courthouses, will be relocated from the San Bernardino Justice Center to their respective courthouses at the Rancho Cucamonga Courthouse located at 8303 Haven Avenue, and at the Victorville Courthouse, located at 14455 Civic Drive.

The Rancho Cucamonga and Victorville courthouses will only accept “Drop-off” documents and moving papers relating to cases being heard in their respective civil courtrooms. These “drop” filings will be processed the next business day. All civil filings will continue to be filed in person at the San Bernardino Justice Center, or electronically using the online eFile portal (<https://www.sb-court.org/efiling/civil-efiling>) until further notice.

The civil courtroom in Rancho Cucamonga is R17 and the civil courtroom in Victorville is V11. Attorneys and parties are encouraged to check the Court Access Portal to confirm where their hearing will be heard.

The Civil Clerks Office and all other civil courtrooms will remain in the San Bernardino Justice Center located at 247 W 3rd Street. There will not be a civil clerk’s office window available at the Rancho Cucamonga or Victorville courthouses at this time.
