SAN BERNARDINO SUPERIOR COURT HOSTS VIRTUAL TOWNHALL ON CIVIL UNREST AND RACISM

SAN BERNARDINO, CA—The San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) Community Outreach Committee is collaborating with local justice partners to host a *Virtual Townhall on Civil Unrest and Racism: What Are We Doing?* scheduled on Thursday, July 30 from noon to 1:00 p.m.
