SAN BERNARDINO, CA— On October 19, 2023, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the appointment of Lenita Skoretz to serve as a Judge in San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC).

The Governor's office released the following statements:

Lenita Skoretz, of San Bernardino County, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the San Bernardino County Superior Court. Skoretz has been a Sole Practitioner since 1997. She earned a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Southern California, Gould School of Law and a Master of Arts degree in History from Andrews University. Skoretz fills the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Bryan Foster.

"We are extremely grateful to the Governor and Secretary Cespedes for their continued commitment to addressing the judicial needs of our County," said Presiding Judge R. Glenn Yabuno. "We congratulate Ms. Skoretz and look forward to working with her."

SBSC has four judicial vacancies and an assessed overall need of 30 judicial officers – the highest judicial need in California. Fulfilling this need is critical to restoring public confidence in the judicial system and expanding access to justice.
